Instruction For Gate Operation:



Once you have received your remote controls and have been assigned an access code you have two options to open your gates:

1.) By Using Your **Remote Control Transmitter:** This device opens the gate from inside your vehicle by pushing the button on the transmitter.

OR: If you are not in your own car and/or do not have your REMOTE with you,

2.) By Manually Entering Your **Access Code:** You have chosen a 4-digit access number, which has been programmed into the gate. When you are next to the call box at the gate, push # followed by your **four digit** access number and the gate will open.

Your visitors and guests will enter by using the visitor call station. They look for your name in the directory, there is a number beside your name, they punch in that number or press the call button, and the phone will ring at your home. Pick up the phone; dial 9 and the gate will open. If you have a telephone that sends short tone pulses, you may have to press 9 twice. If you do not pick up the phone the connection will be broken and access will be denied.

If you do not want to grant the visitor access, simply hang up the phone. If you are on the telephone when a visitor tries to contact you, they will receive a busy signal. You can eliminate this problem by ordering "Call Waiting" from your telephone company.

For you or your guest to exit the property, simply pull up to the gate and it will open. No remote or entry code is required to exit.
